Support BCCO: Advertise in our June 2020 Concert Program!

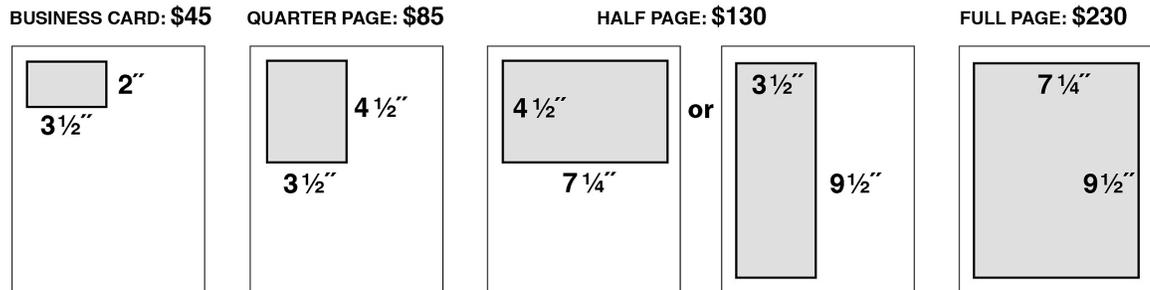

Artwork specifications and ways to submit your ad:

Online: Create the ad to exactly match one of the sizes, oriented as pictured above. **Save as a "Press Quality" PDF, with images saved at 300 ppi, and all fonts embedded; or a 300ppi or higher, grey-scale JPEG.** Our concert program is black & white. Upload your ad at our website, www.bcco.org/program-ads. You may pay online with a credit card or a PayPal account.

Mail: Send the **camera-ready** artwork (for example, a business card) and check payable to BCCO, P.O. Box 310, Berkeley CA 94701-0310 using the enclosed envelope. Commercially printed, or high-resolution laser printed artwork is required.

In person: You can submit your ad and check to a Chorus member who contacts you.
